Around 123 persons suffered food poisoning after consuming food at a religious function in Govindpura area of Padra town in Vadodara district on Sunday night.

The residents including children were immediately rushed to a community health centre where their condition is stable. After the incident, the Vadodara district administration too formed teams to carry out health surveillance in the area.

Officials said that the residents were invited for a Niyaz ceremony that was organized by a resident Abu Bakar Zakir Hussain Saiyed. A total of 250 individuals had consumed food at the Niyaz ceremony where kheer and dal-pulav was served to the invitees. After dinner, many of the invitees, started complaining of stomach ache, vomiting and nausea.

“A total of 123 individuals had suffered food poisoning. While 60 of them were provided primary treatment, 63 were hospitalized. Of these, 31 were admitted at

community health centre, while the remaining were admitted at private hospitals. All of them are stable,” said epidemic medical officer Dr Rahul Singh.

Vadodara district collector Atul Gor and district development officer Dr Rajendra Patel had also rushed to the spot to know the condition of the patients. The duo had asked health teams to remain on standby on Monday as well. Eight teams were roped in to carry out health screening.
