About 50 students of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) at Mupparam village of Dharmasagar mandal in Warangal Urban district fell ill after having dinner late on Thursday. Sources said that before going to bed, many students complained of stomach ache and vomiting sensation.

After the other students informed special officer Neeraja Reddy, some 37 students were sent to MGM hospital in Warangal. About 10 students were sent to Dharmasagar PHC and the remaining were treated at KGBV Mupparam.

Ghanapur (Station) MLA Rajaiiah, a doctor by profession, checked the students and enquired about those admitted to MGM hospital. He coordinated with MGM hospital medical experts and said that if required, students can be sent to Hyderabad for treatment. The students are recovering at MGM and PHC in Warangal. District Education Officer (DEO) Narayana Reddy, alongwith other officials, rushed to Mupparam village to monitor the situation. Parents alleged that the mess contractor, Dharmaraju, has been providing inferior quality ingredients for the meals. They demanded an inquiry into the incident.
