Students of Rastogi Nursing College located in Durg district of Chhattisgarh have become victims of food poisoning. Out of which one student has also died. Balod resident student used to study in Nursing College. All the students were admitted to the private hospital in Bhilai after complaining of vomiting and diarrhea.

Rastogi Nursing College incident

In Bhilai's Rastogi Nursing College, about 39 girl students were being admitted one after the other to the hi-tech hospital, in which all of them complained of vomiting and diarrhea. In which a student died during treatment. It is being told that the shocking thing in this case is that the girls are reaching the hospital since July 28, according to the police administration, 39 girl students suffering from food poisoning are admitted in the hospital for three days. But Rastogi Nursing College hid this fact.

Bhilai Municipal Corporation Mayor Neeraj Pal reached Hi-Tech Hospital to know the condition of the students who got sick due to food poisoning, where he met the girl students. In this meeting, the girl students alleged that they were given stale food in the mess. Because of which she became ill. In this matter, Mayor Neeraj Pal has ordered an inquiry. But Rastogi Nursing College is continuously denying the allegation of being given stale food.
