Tragedy has struck in the joint Kurnool district. The guests who came for the auspicious occasion fell ill when the wedding meal went awry. As about 20 people fell ill, a medical camp was set up. What actually happened is that 20 guests got food poisoning due to the consumption of contaminated food by the wedding guests in Guntakandala village of Velugodu mandal of Nandyala district.

After eating that meal, vomiting and diarrhea started from them. Immediately after receiving the information, the officials set up a medical camp in the village. The victims are being monitored by Assistant DMHO Kantarao Naik, Doctors Vamsi Krishna and Health Supervisor Srinivas. Also, District Health Officer (DMHO) Venkataramana visited the victims who are being treated at Velugodu Hospital.

Meanwhile, the authorities are investigating whether this could have happened due to eating, or whether the meal became contaminated due to the boring water.
