City hospitals registered 17 new cases of chikungunya and five cases of dengue between March 1 and 26. From January 1 to March 26, 95 chikungunya and 29 dengue cases were registered.

Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation's health department data shows that chikungunya and dengue cases were slightly down from last March.

The city hospitals had registered 21 cases of chikungunya and 12 cases of dengue in March 2021.

Malaria cases in the city this month stood at 7, down from 11 in March last year while there were no cases of falciparum this month against one case in March 2021. During January 1 to March 26 15 cases of malaria and three cases of falciparum were registered in the city.

AMC registers most complaints for mosquito control from West, North West, South and South West zones.

AMC figures showed a slight increase in waterborne diseases this month. This month so far, city hospitals registered 449 cases of diarrhoea against 440 cases in March 2021.

There were 133 cases of jaundice and 137 cases of typhoid this month against 93 and 217 cases respectively in March 2021.
