Title:	More than 13 people are sick due to consumption of contaminated water in Vijayanagara, Karnataka

The case of getting sick after drinking contaminated water continues in the state, more than 13 people have fallen ill after drinking contaminated water in Badeladaku Gollarhatti of Kudligi taluk of Vijayanagara district.

Due to the unscientific work done at the Jaljevan Mission work site in the village, the drinking water pipes were broken and due to the mixed sewage water, the villagers who drank the contaminated water developed vomiting and diarrhea and were immediately admitted to the hospital.

“The taluk administration and local gram panchayat officials and water supply staff are not concerned. They are playing with the health of the villagers,” alleged the villagers of Dodda Gollarhatti.

"The pipe has burst in three or four places near the road pit and embankment next to Kuppinakere village. Badeladaku Doddagollarhatti village has been supplied with contaminated water for the past couple of days, and the villagers who drank the water have started vomiting," Health Department officials estimated. At present the sample of contaminated water has been sent to Bellary testing station. Congress MLA Srinivas from Kudligi Constituency visited and examined those who fell ill after consuming contaminated water.
