9 undertrial prisoners lodged within the lock-up of Nalasopara police station in Maharashtra's Palghar district fell unwell after allegedly consuming poisoned meals, following which they have been taken to a hospital. This data was given by the senior inspector of Nalasopara police station.

Senior Inspector of Nalasopara police station gave data
Lunch was served to the undertrial prisoners on the Nalasopara police station lockup at round 2 pm on Tuesday, the official mentioned. Senior Inspector Vilas Supe of Nalasopara police station mentioned that two of them felt unwell and vomited after having the meals. Later, different undertrials additionally complained of getting the same downside.

Prisoners had eaten authorities mess meals
On the identical time, after the incident, these undertrial prisoners have been taken to the federal government hospital in Sopara for remedy, the place their situation is alleged to be out of hazard, the police officer knowledgeable that the meals was offered from the federal government mess. After the incident, meals samples have been despatched to the lab for examination.
