With 14 new cases in the past 24 hours, dengue cases in the district crossed the 500 mark on Saturday and stood at 509. There are 68 active cases now officially.

Areas in urban villages such as Chhalera, Sadarpur, Surajpur and Nithari are among the top contributors to dengue cases.

Private as well as government hospitals, however, said that the cases are still very high and new cases are coming in every day. Most private hospitals have run out of beds and are now using beds that were kept reserved for Covid patients.

Most of these cases are not added to the district's tally as all samples are not tested by the two government approved labs. Doctors also say that several cases of dengue and typhoid combination are being seen this year, especially in children.

Meanwhile, the health department is continuing with its container survey to check stagnant water around residential areas. "We hope people continue to drain out fresh

water and not keep stagnant water at home. Thermocol boxes are a special hazard and should be emptied. We are also receiving complaints of water in the basement of high-rise societies and are taking action along with the Authorities,” said Rajesh Sharma, district malaria officer.

No new scrub typhus or Leptospirosis cases have been reported in Noida. There were a total of five scrub typhus and three Leptospirosis cases reported this year.
