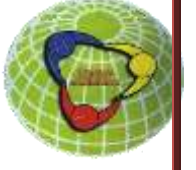

Title:	170 pigs died of African Swine Fever in Idukki, Kerala

African swine fever has been confirmed again in Vattikudi panchayat of Idukki, Kerala. The disease has been confirmed in the pigs of Bina Joseph at Vattikudi Patamugam Kadalikat of the farm. It is learned that 170 of Bina's pigs have already died of African swine fever.

African swine fever has been confirmed in pigs at a farm operating in Patamukhi, Vattikudi Panchayat, Idukki, while 170 pigs have succumbed to African swine fever in the last one week at Padamugam Kadalikat Bina's farm. After the pig died, its body sample was sent to the Bangalore laboratory. Now the lab in Bangalore has confirmed that those pigs have African Swine Fever.

It has been learned that 60 pigs are still left in Padamugam Kadalikat Bina's farm and they are likely to be euthanized as a precautionary measure to prevent the spread of the disease.

Wards 4, 13, 14, 15 and 16 of Vattikkuru panchayat within one kilometer radius of the farm have been declared as disease-affected areas, while panchayats like Kamakshi,
