Title:	Over 100 people get gastroenteritis due to polluted water in district Nanded, Maharashtra

Consumption of polluted water available at Omra Tamda in Mahur tehsil of the district resulted in causing gastroenteritis to 102 persons during the last 3 days.

Three women patients have been shifted to Yavatmal for treatment, today.

Visiting the place and inspecting the water the concern tehsil health officers issued a notification to the people to not to consume the polluted water. From April 26 many people after consuming water from a deep well at Omara Tanda suffered from gastroenteritis. They were admitted at Mahur Rural Hospital. The number of patients raised to 102 today.

For not getting satisfactory treatment most of the patients turned to private hospitals. The serious patients were taken to Yavatmal government hospital by using an ambulance. The District Contagious Diseases officer Munde and Phulwal also visited the spot and issued instruction to Dr SB Bhise for treatment. Despite having instruction to stop seepage of drainage water into the well and disinfect the water nothing was done during the last one months. The Deputy Superintendent of Zilla Parishad Samadhan Jadhav also visited the spot.
