

1. Authorisation to incur expenditure will be subject to the guidelines, terms and conditions laid down in the Administrative Approval of the State PIP for 2012-13, Records of Proceedings of the NPCC. A certificate to this effect should accompany the Utilization Certificates in due course.
2. The **Nature of the Grant-in-Aid is being released is recurring** and the objective for which it is being released is as below:-
The project development objective is to improve the information available to the Government Health Services and Private Health Care providers on a set of high-priority diseases and risk factors, with a view to improve on the ground responses to such diseases and risk factors.
3. The State shall not make any changes in allocations or re-appropriations among different components/ activities without approval of the, MOH & FW, Government of India.
4. The State shall ensure that 25% of its share based on release of funds by Government of India is credited to the State Health Society Account within one month of the release order.
5. The State shall ensure completion of Delegation of Administrative and Financial Powers during the current financial year and funding of Integrated Disease Surveillance Programmes will be based on clear delegation as per earlier directions.
6. The State shall follow all the financial management systems under Integrated Disease Surveillance Project and shall submit within six months of closing of financial year Statutory Audit Reports, Utilization Certificates, Quarterly Summary on Concurrent Audit, FMRs / SOEs and Statement of Fund Position showing unspent balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance.

8. The fund to the Karnataka State Health Society has been released from Budget Estimate (Domestic Budget Component) for the financial year 2012-13 of MOH&FW, Government of India. Releases made under this Sanction Order are only in respect of Programmes/ Schemes/ activities to institutions or organisations set up as Autonomous organizations under a specific statute or as a Society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 or Indian Trusts Act, 1882 or other statutes as per Rule 206 (a) of GFR 2005, for which:
 - A. Unspent balance for the previous year 2011-12 has been adjusted.
 - B. Provisional UCs/FMRs/SOEs upto 31st March 2012 have been received from the States
 - C. UC is pending for the year 2011-12 from Karnataka State.
(Applicable only while releasing the second instalment and statutory audit)
9. The accounts of the grantee institutions/organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit both by the C & AG of India under the provisions of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit wing of the office of CCA, MOH & FW.
10. The expenditure will be met out of the approved Budget Estimates under Demand No.46 – Department of Health & Family Welfare, **Major Head “2210” Medical and Public Health 06789 Special Component Plan for SC (Minor Head) 13- Integrated Disease Surveillance Project 1301 Grants to States Societies for various Components (GC) 130131- Grant –in-Aid-General** to State Societies during the current financial year, 2012-13 (Plan).
11. The Copy of BE for the financial year 2012-13 is already sent for your ready reference & necessary action.
12. Grant-in-Aid to be released to **Karnataka State Health and Family Welfare Society – IDSP in this SC Component of 2nd Instalment is Rs. 38.80 Lacs.** Rs. 94.32 lakhs has already been released from Gen Component of 1st Instalment.
